To the Constables of the Town of Nantucket:

*GREETING:*

*In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Nantucket qualified to vote in Town affairs to go to the Nantucket High School at 10 Surfside Road in said Nantucket, on*

***TUESDAY, THE THIRD DAY OF JUNE, 2008 BETWEEN THE HOURS OF  
7:00 AM and 8:00 PM***

*for the following purpose:*

To cast their vote as "YES" or "NO" on the following ballot questions:

*Debt exclusion override questions pursuant to G. L. Chapter 59, s. 21C(k):*

1. Shall the Town of Nantucket be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition Two and One-Half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond to be issued in order to pay for professional services for design, permitting, architecture, construction supervision and other related professional services, and for the construction, installation and equipping, of a public safety facility at 2 Fairgrounds Road?

Shall the Town of Nantucket be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition Two and One-Half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond to be issued in order to pay for the following capital expenditures: replacement of one fire engine; replacement of the finger pier at the Brant Point boat house; interior building repairs and improvements to the Town Buildings at 16 Broad Street and 2 Fairgrounds Road; repair and improvements to the Teen Center located at First Way; repairs and improvements to the Visitor restrooms located at 1 Folger's Court in Siasconset and renovation of Visitor restrooms at

25 Federal Street; replacement of one packer trash truck; replacement of sections of guardrail along Polpis Road; costs associated with road reconstruction projects; the purchase of DPW mowing equipment; costs associated with roadway improvement at the intersection of Orange and Union Streets; replacement of equipment, furniture and fixtures at all of the Nantucket Public Schools; replacement of the 20,000 gallon fuel storage tank for the Nantucket Public Schools; building improvements at Nantucket High School, Middle School and Elementary School; costs associated with the development of new playing fields and associated facilities; costs associated with school space reconfiguration; costs associated with a school space needs study and expansion design; costs associated with design and construction of a bicycle path on Cliff Road?
